The date of Departmental Examination for promotion to the rank of ASI/LASI (UB) and ASI (AB) in West Bengal Police - 2023 has been scheduled on **18.06.2023 (Sunday) in two sessions** as per following schedule:

Both the examinations will consist of **Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)** and **Descriptive Question(s)**. OMR sheet will be provided for answering MCQ part while separate answer book will be provided for the descriptive part which will consist of the question(s) on report writing as per syllabus. Sample of OMR has also been uploaded. There will be **negative marking** on OMR based part i.e., $\frac{1}{4}$ th of the allotted marks for a particular question will be deducted for each incorrect answer. Separate admit cards for each session will be uploaded on the websites & **pen will be provided by West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.**

The e-Admit Cards will be available on the website of West Bengal Police Recruitment Board (<https://prb.wb.gov.in>) & West Bengal Police (www.wbpolice.gov.in) from **08.06.2023** on keying of **Application Sl. No. & Date of Birth** of the candidates. Candidates shall have to produce the printout of their e-Admit cards at the allotted venues for appearing in the said examination with a proper and original proof of identity as mentioned in the Admit card.

The candidates are strongly advised not to carry any articles declared as prohibited in **Sl. No. 6 of Important Instructions** given in the Admit card.

The candidates are also advised to follow the instructions given on their Admit Card and visit these websites on a regular basis.
